**CONSTRUCTION WORKERS
ON NYC GOVERNMENT PROJECTS
ARE ENTITLED TO PREVAILING
WAGES AND BENEFITS.**

FOR EXAMPLE:*

Asbestos Handlers:

\$31.50 hourly wages & \$11.45 hourly benefits

Carpenters:

\$43.02 hourly wages & \$35.96 hourly benefits

Electricians (A):

\$49 hourly wages & \$40.40 hourly benefits

Iron Workers (Ornamental):

\$39.85 hourly wages & \$35.87 hourly benefits

Laborers(Excavation):

\$36.64 hourly wages & \$26.31 hourly benefits

Laborers (Mason Tender):

\$31.72 hourly wages & \$21.02 hourly benefits

Painters:

\$36 hourly wages & \$21.82 hourly benefits

Plumbers:

\$49.11 hourly wages & \$35.26 hourly benefits

** Most of these rates are valid through June 30, 2010.*
