**LIU STATEMENT ON CONTINUED DISPUTE
OVER SCHOOL BUS CONTRACTS**

NEW YORK, N.Y. – City Comptroller John C. Liu stated the following today on the continued dispute over school bus contracts:

“As the school bus drivers’ dispute over proposed new DOE contracts continues, the onus is on City Hall to negotiate with workers instead of unilaterally trying to strip them of employment protections that are in the best interests of workers and students alike. At stake is the quality and safety of the busing the City provides special-needs students. The administration’s heavy-handed tactics with workers, on display also in the DOE’s failed talks with teachers over evaluations, are disruptive and exceedingly counterproductive. Enough already.”
