LIU STATEMENT ON LANDER ZONING REPORT

NEW YORK, N.Y. – City Comptroller John C. Liu stated the following in response to questions about Council Member Brad Lander’s report on mandatory inclusionary zoning (IZ):

“For the past dozen years, Mayor Bloomberg has used the City’s zoning policies to give unearned windfalls to his wealthy developer friends. In the process, he has created a severe shortage of affordable housing in every borough. Council Member Lander’s report, which urges the City to make affordable housing a mandatory part of any rezoning, serves as a blueprint for correcting this injustice.”
