DAMAGE DESCRIPTION AND DIMENSIONS: PA-02-NY-1869-PW-00019(0): During the incident period beginning November 12, 2009, strong winds and surf action associated with Tropical Depression Ida and a Nor'easter resulted in erosion to an area of supporting sand structure beneath a wood deck at the Suffolk County owned concession stand at Meschutt Beach. The area measured approximately 8 ft deep X 30 ft wide X 38 LF.						
SCOPE OF WORK: PA-02-NY-1869-PW-00019(0): The applicant utilized force account labor, equipment and material to place 400 Tons of bunker sand to an area of supporting sand structure measuring approximately 8 ft deep X 30 ft wide X 38 LF. This material is required to support the wood deck posts attached to the wood deck. This work returned the facility to its pre-disaster design, function and capacity. Hazard Mitigation was discussed with the applicant and none could be identified. The applicant has a permit allowing 5,000 CY of sand to be placed annually at this beach and the placement of this foundation sand material was placed under this permit. (Permit Attached) The sub grantee is requesting Direct Administrative Costs that are directly chargeable to this specific project. Associated eligible work is related to administration of this Public Assistance project only and in accordance with 44 CFR – 13.22. These costs are treated consistently and uniformly as direct cost in all Federal awards and other sub grantee activities and are not included in any approved indirect cost rates.
