NYC TEACHERS' RETIREMENT SYSTEM
PENSION BOARD MEETING**
1st NYC Pension Fund to Ever Do So

NEW YORK, NY – Today, the \$42 billion New York City Teachers' Retirement System — the city's largest pension fund — will conduct the first-ever live webcast of the Board's regularly scheduled Investment Meeting. The meeting will begin at 9:30 A.M. with online access available at: <http://comptroller.nyc.gov/mymoneynyc/pensionnyc/webcast/>

Last week, Comptroller John C. Liu announced Pension NYC, a new transparency initiative to provide taxpayers, retirees and the general public unprecedented access to information about the \$114.9 billion New York City Pension System through a number of different tools. Today marks the first phase of that initiative.
