LIU ON DEEPENING REPORTS OF E911 PROBLEMS

NEW YORK, N.Y. – City Comptroller John C. Liu stated the following about today’s [Daily News article](#) reporting that City officials were aware of problems linked to the new Emergency 911 call system prior to Ariel Russo’s death:

“As today’s Daily News report again demonstrates, the Bloomberg Administration has repeatedly and knowingly put New Yorkers at risk with their botched handling of the emergency call system. Each new revelation makes it even more impossible to believe the Administration’s excuses—and we need a full, honest reckoning immediately. Until that happens, all we can do is pray that lives will not be unnecessarily lost because of this problem-plagued system.”
